

Rewards for master's degree students that affect the order of enrolment

a) Students who are members of the Standing Committee or a committee set up by a governing body¹ who attend 80% of the committee's meetings in a semester go up 10% (rounded up) in the lists corresponding to the order of enrolment in the following semester.

Students who are members of two or more committees, in accordance with the conditions in the previous paragraph, go up 20% (rounded up) in the lists corresponding to the order of enrolment in the following semester.

b) Mentors in the Open Classroom (Aula Lliure) who complete a semester (that is, who are awarded 2 ECTS credits for university activities) go up 20% (rounded up) in the lists corresponding to the order of enrolment in the following semester.
